

# GURSABAD CAMP 2025

## Terms and Conditions for Gursabad Camp

Welcome to Gursabad Camp 2026! These Terms and Conditions apply to your registration, participation, and use of our instruments and camp services. By registering for and attending the camp, you agree to comply with these Terms and Conditions. Please read them carefully.

### 1. Registration and Payment

#### 1.1 Registration

To participate in the Gursabad Camp, you must complete the registration form and submit any necessary documents, including but not limited to health forms, consent forms, and payment.

#### 1.2 Payment

Full payment for the camp must be made prior to attending. If payment is not received by the specified deadline, your spot may be forfeited, and the registration may be cancelled.

#### 1.3 Refund Policy

Refunds will be provided under the following conditions:

- Full refund if the cancellation is made at least one month before the start date. Refunds may be issued if the camp is cancelled or postponed due to unforeseen circumstances.

### 2. Camp Duration and Hours

#### 2.1 Camp Dates and Times

The camp will run from Thursday 30th July – Sunday 2nd August 2026 (9:00am – 6:00pm Daily) at Karamsar Centre Ilford.

#### 2.2 Late Arrival or Early Departure

Late arrival or early departure may be arranged on a case-by-case basis with prior approval from camp organizers. Please notify us in advance of any schedule changes.

### 3. Health and Safety

#### 3.1 Health and Medical Information

Participants are required to provide accurate and up-to-date health information during registration. This includes any medical conditions, allergies, medications, dietary requirements, or special needs. Failure to disclose relevant health information may result in a denial of participation or dismissal from the camp.

### **3.2 Emergency Contact**

Each participant must provide an emergency contact person who can be reached in case of an emergency during the camp.

### **3.3 Insurance**

We strongly recommend that all participants have personal health insurance. The camp is not responsible for any injuries, accidents, or loss of property.

## **4. Conduct and Behaviour**

### **4.1 Code of Conduct**

Participants are expected to behave respectfully and responsibly throughout the camp. Disruptive behaviour, bullying, or failure to follow instructions from camp staff may result in immediate dismissal without refund.

### **4.2 Alcohol and Drugs**

The possession or consumption of alcohol, illegal drugs, or any substances deemed inappropriate is strictly prohibited on camp premises. Participants found violating this policy will be removed from the camp.

### **4.3 Respect for Property**

Participants are responsible for any damage to camp property or equipment. If damages are caused by a participant, they may be held liable for the cost of repairs or replacement.

## **5. Camp Activities**

### **5.1 Camp Schedule**

The camp will offer a variety of music-related activities, including but not limited to lessons, performances, workshops and outdoor activities. The specific activities and schedule may vary and are subject to change at the discretion of the camp organizers.

### **5.2 Specialized Sessions**

Some camp sessions may require prior skill assessments. Participants will be informed in advance of any such requirements.

### **5.3 Recording and Photography**

Participants may be recorded or photographed during camp activities. By attending, participants consent to the use of their likeness in promotional materials, including but not

limited to brochures, websites, and social media platforms. If a participant prefers not to be photographed or recorded, they must inform camp staff upon arrival.

## **6. Liability Waiver**

### **6.1 General Liability**
